

Priorities identified by businesses

The recent survey, which was completed by more than 100 businesses and organisations, has identified a range of key priority projects for the city centre and these are being developed as follows:

OBJECTIVE ONE A POSITIVE ENVIRONMENT

Likely to include work to reduce street begging and rough sleeping, litter and graffiti removal and continuation of the pavement hot-washing programme.



OBJECTIVE TWO – BETTER FOR BUSINESS

Likely to include projects to encourage investment into the city centre, pronounced additional marketing and promotion of Bradford and further business updates, networking events and staff training.





OBJECTIVE THREE – A VIBRANT EXPERIENCE

Likely to include more major events and festivals, new partnerships with the City of Culture team and further work to gain Purple Flag accreditation for the city.

Timetable to the ballot

Following the ongoing period of consultation, the following timescales will apply:

6th July 2023	Business Plan launch
17th August 2023	Businesses will be given formal notice of the BID renewal ballot
31st August 2023	Ballot papers will be issued to businesses along with a copy of the Business Plan and a replypaid envelope to use when casting your vote
28th September	Ballot Day. All postal votes need to be received by 5pm on this date in order to qualify to be counted
29th September 2023	Ballot result announced
